Misc. Items

- Cloth Towels
- Spray bottles
- Carrying Kennels
- Antibacterial, water-free gel, ex. Purell
- Paper towels
- Simple Green Cleaner or other non-toxic, eco-friendly cleaners
- Scrub brushes
- Toys for large birds- macaws cockatoos and other parrots
- Reptile supplies- Eco Earth, Repti-bark, Calci-sand, Hide logs/caves, etc.
- Pillowcases with no holes
- Extra large Puppy training Pads
- Newspaper

Food Items

- Cereal: Cheerios type (sugar-free or low fat)
- Fruits: mangos, papayas, other tropical fruits, apples, bananas, grapes, berries
- Vegetables: dark, leafy greens, such as mustard greens, turnip tops, collard greens; broccoli, celery, yams, garbanzo beans, carrots, peas, Brussel sprouts, etc. (**NO** Iceberg lettuce)
- Eggs
- Unsalted nuts - almonds, walnuts, peanuts, etc.
- Vegetable Oil
